Tour to Kyiv Pecherska Lavra

The Kyiv Pecherska Lavra church complex is a historic Orthodox Christian monastery situated atop the right bank of the mighty Dnipro River. The monastery was founded in 1051, today is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and was voted one of the Seven Wonders of Ukraine recently. There are truly few places in the world that are as strikingly beautiful and supremely tranquil. The complex includes 20 hectares of territory with 16 churches, two underground cave systems that contain the mummified remains of Orthodox saints and their relics, a central cathedral, seminary, and a (recently reopened after reconstruction) 96.5-meter-tall bell tower. This is a deep cultural experience.

Tour to The Motherland Monument + Museum of military equipment and vehicles

Towering 62 meters over the banks of the Dnipro River is one of Kyiv's most striking monuments - the Motherland. Surrounding the sculpture is a beautiful and spacious 10 hectares' memorial complex that includes the large and memorable «Flame of Glory» one of the biggest displays of military vehicles and artillery in the country, and Ukraine's World War II History Museum. The museum, one of the largest in Ukraine, houses one of the biggest collection of World War II relics in one place (it has 400,000+ exhibits!). The complex is not just for history buffs, who will enjoy both the breadth and comprehensiveness of the complex, but for everyone attracted to rich stories of sacrifice, valor, devotion and patriotism. **Duration:** 2 hours

Duration: 3 hours

During this Lviv walking tour led by a professional local guide, you will discover the Rynok Square, the Opera Theater and the main historical and contemporary sites of the old town. You will hear stories and learn secrets that will allow you to better get to know Lviv. Unlike many cities in Ukraine, Lviv

was lucky enough to escape the destruction in World War Two, and nowadays its fascinating streets and numerous museums make it one of the most exciting places in Ukraine to explore.

You will discover the historic center of Lviv, which was included in the UNESCO World Heritage List and walk old town's main avenues, squares, and narrow cobbled streets.

During the tour in the medieval part of Lviv, you will see the place where a famous writer Leopold von Sacher-Masoch, the figure behind the term "masochism" was born, and then we also stop by the Masoch Cafe. You will learn more about the gas lamp invention - the first gas lamp in the world was invented in Lviv. One of the contemporary places that the tour highlights is the Dzyga Gallery, an artistic terrain of contemporary artists. Last but not least, you will discover the medieval defense system of the city: the Gunpowder Tower and the Arsenal building, the site of one of the biggest collections of medieval weapons in the county.
